Nursery 30 hours Provision

Children qualify for 30 free hours if both child's parents (or one parent in a single parent family) work a minimum of 16 hours per week, paid at the national minimum wage. Your child will not qualify if either parent earns more than £100,000 per year. If your child does not qualify for the 30 hours, he or she is still entitled to 15 free hours.

You can check your eligibility online by using the government's Childcare website (www.childcarechoices.gov.uk) or the Childcare Calculator (www.gov.uk/childcare-calculator).

If you experience any delay in obtaining your code, please inform the school office asap. Please complete the form below and return to school the term prior to your child starting in nursery.

There is a daily charge of £7.50 for the lunch hour which does not form part of the 30 hours. You will need to provide a packed lunch for your child. You can take your child home for lunch if you prefer.
