Bravery can only happen when we feel safe. Creating an open and supportive environment where children feel safe to come and speak with you about their fears will mean that they will feel more equipped to face them because they have support from you. During these conversations, it can also be helpful to share some calming techniques with your children, such as deep breathing (prolonging the out-breath) or visualisations. These tips will not only help your children find their brave, but will be tools for supporting their general mental health.
