A VISIT FROM THE EWO

Last week, we had a visit from the Education Welfare Officer, whose main role is to work with us to get all children to school regularly. Our current attendance levels as a school are sitting at 94.83%. Whilst we are pleased with this figure, we'd love to get to our target of 95%. Our attendance percentages this term have been affected by the high level of absence during the first week of term and a letter was sent out regarding this last week with more information about how we can work together to ensure children do not regularly miss school.

GIRLS' FOOTBALL MATCH Vs FOULDS SCHOOL

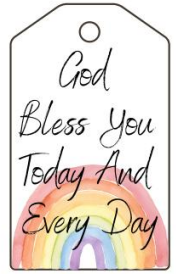

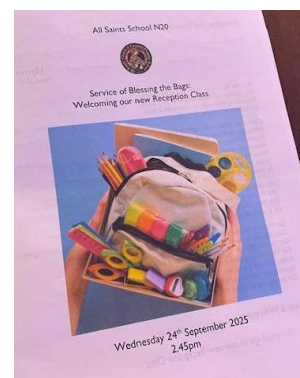

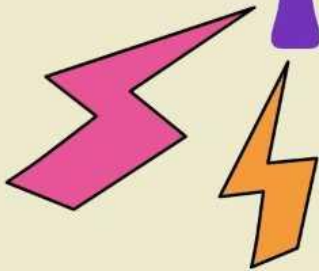
