Does your child experience anxiety? Anxiety can feel so overwhelming for children and as parents/carers it can be difficult to witness them experience frequent heightened anxiety.



It can help children to understand what happens in their bodies and brains when they experience anxiety. Everyone's brain has an alarm system that tells them when they might be in danger. This alarm system is incredibly helpful as it keeps us safe so we want it to be there. However, this alarm system can sometimes misread situations or get in the habit of turning on more frequently than needed. Here is where parents and carers can help their children to navigate when their brain is sending a false alarm. One could say "Your brain is trying to protect you, but it is getting a bit mixed up right now. Let's find a way to calm it together." You can then do some breathing or grounding exercises with your children. Over time and with your support, children will learn to internalise this understanding of when their brain is getting a little confused and how to calm it.
