A VISIT FROM LUCY NOGUERA

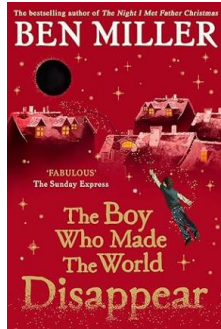

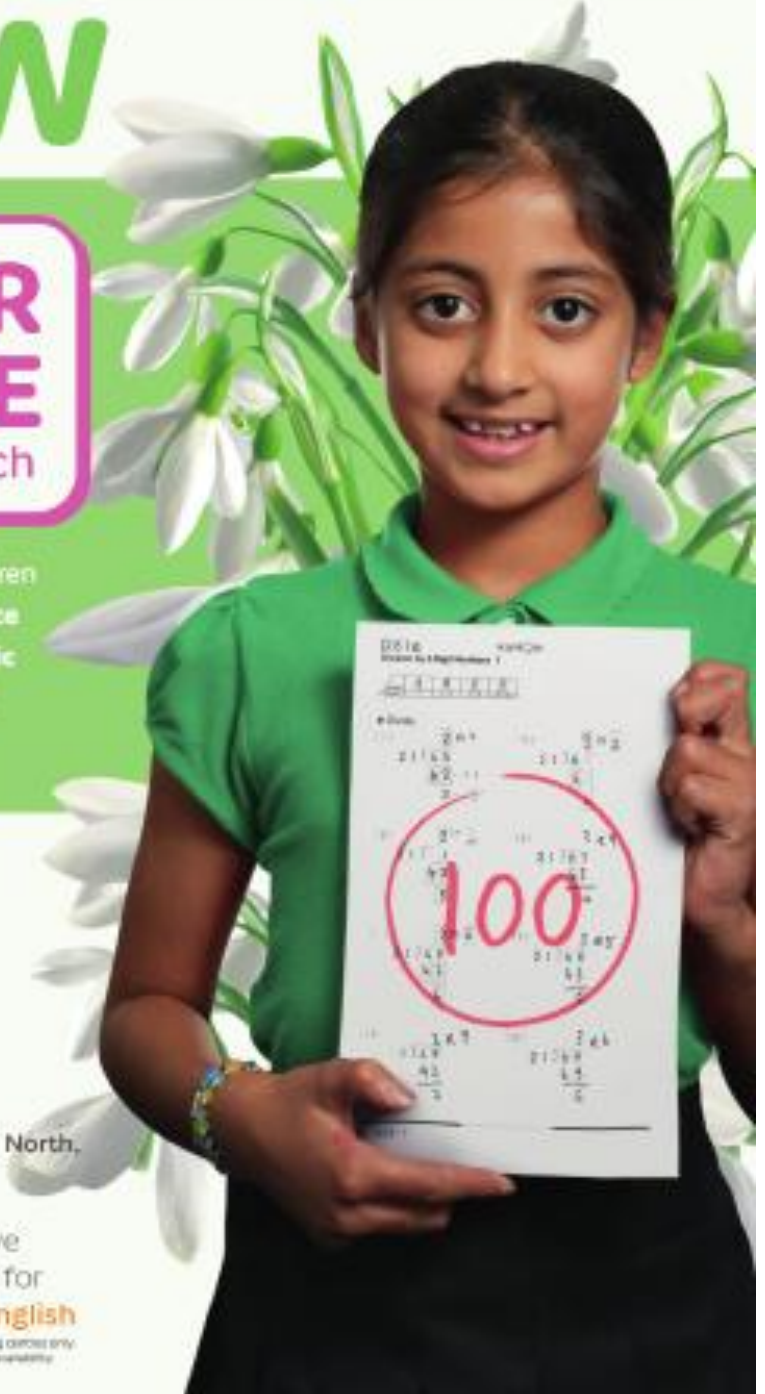
