A VISIT FROM THE EDUCATIONAL WELFARE OFFICER

This week we received a visit from the Educational Welfare Officer, who is responsible for supporting schools with their attendance levels. All Saints' currently has an attendance rate of 94.58% which is below our target of 95%.

We understand that children may need to take time off school due to illness, however the more time children can attend school, the better it is for their learning and their ability to feel settled in their class, so we ask parents to work with us to ensure children attend school wherever possible.

As a reminder, if your child is unwell you must contact the school to report the absence either by phone, text or e-mail. Any absence over 3 days will require evidence either by way of a doctor's letter, appointment confirmation, or any other evidence which can confirm the absence.

We are working towards improving our whole school attendance to above 95% and hope you can support us in achieving this.

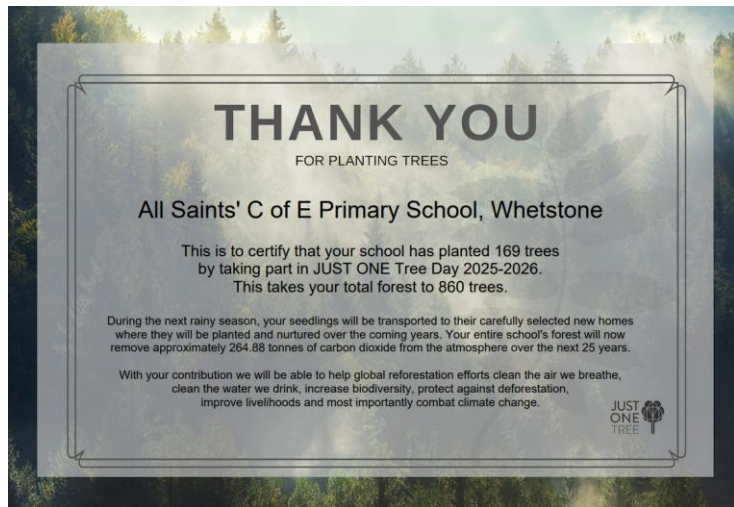
