children have a go at practising their cricket skills. Children will be coming home today with a flyer for Peter's Cricket Camp during half term, if you are interested in booking.

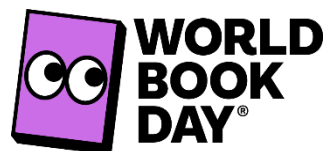


### ASSA VALENTINE'S DAY CAKE SALE

### WORLD BOOK DAY

World Book Day is coming up on **Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March** and this year

## YEAR 6 TRIP TO THE RAF MUSEUM

'On Thursday the 5th of February, Y6 went to the RAF Museum and had a really fun time learning all about satellites and how to keep them safe when coming back to Earth. We learnt all about heat shields and how to make parachutes out of different types of materials. It was really fun because we all got to compete against each other in groups of three and had to work altogether to earn teamwork points.

After, we all drew our designs and made our team names and we got started on building are heat shields for our satellites. We all got given the same materials such as paper, bubble wrap, cling film and tin foil. With these materials we had to create our heat shields. We had to think about how to make our heat shields waterproof and how to keep the temperature low. Once we had finished making our heat shields, we made our designs for our parachutes; we had the options to use silk fabric, plastic bags or tissue paper. After we had finished, we took all our satellites to a high area to test out our parachutes and how well they work. The longer they took, the more points we got. After we tested that out, we tested how well our heat shield works. The RAF members took off the parachute and put all the satellites in boiling hot water for 35 seconds each. After that they cut open all of the satellites and checked the temperature of each one. At the end off the day, they (RAF staff members) added up all off the points and announced the winners; even though there were only 3 people who won, we all had an amazing day.'
