SCHOOL COUNCIL VISIT TO ST PAUL'S CATHEDRAL

On Thursday, some of our School Council representatives from Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 were invited on an exciting trip to St Paul's Cathedral to take part in the London Diocesan Board for Schools (LDBS) annual service, a event that celebrates 100 years of incredible work by the LDBS. The service this year focused on the theme *The Power of Forgiveness: Restoring Relationships*. The service focused on the story of Peter, a man who disowned his best friend, Jesus, but whose relationship was later restored.

'Yesterday, all the School Council from year three and up had an amazing trip to St Paul's Cathedral where we learnt all about the power of forgiveness. We left school at 12:15 and headed to the tube station. We went all the way into central London and walked towards the cathedral. We had to be seated by 1:45 pm. Barnet Council is offering FREE car seat checking to ensure all children in car seats are travelling safely. A trained expert from Good Egg Safety will be available to inspect seats, fix errors and provide advice. Last year, 92% of seats checked had errors, many serious enough to endanger a child in a collision.
