UPDATE ON PARKING ISSUES

Over the last few months, we have been working hard to ensure that parents are parking safely and legally at school drop off and pick up, keeping our children and community safe.

We have been working closely with our local councillor, Councillor Ezra Cohen, and we have also had a visit from local police officers this week in response to numerous concerns raised by local residents regarding parking on the roads around the school.

Some of the solutions we have been discussing, to promote safer parking include:

- A period of enhanced monitoring, referred to as Special Enforcement, with enforcement officers patrolling at drop off and pick up times issuing penalty charges to anyone parking illegally. You may have seen some of these officers around this week.
- We are planning a meeting at the school, along with our local councillor and local residents, as well as the school community, to discuss parking issues. We will keep you informed once a date is confirmed.
- We are in discussion with the local trees team and roads team regarding planting trees and installing wooden bollards in certain areas to discourage illegal parking on verges and pavements.

We hope you can support us in working together to keep our children and local community safe, and ensuring we park respectfully and safely.

April is Stress Awareness Month

Stress is the body's natural response to pressure. A little bit of stress can help us keep focused and alert, but too much can impact our well-being leading to problems with anxiety and depression.

Common causes of stress include schoolwork and tests, friendship issues, worries about finances or health, and big life changes like moving house. Recognising triggers and practising stress management are key to maintaining wellbeing.

Feeling more irritable than usual, having difficulty sleeping, and becoming more withdrawn are signs to look out for. High levels of the stress hormone cortisol can disrupt gut health and lower our immune system.

Strategies to manage stress in adults and children include talking about our feelings with someone we trust. It is also important to get enough sleep, rest, and exercise which releases endorphins improving mood, and to set aside time to do things that we enjoy.
