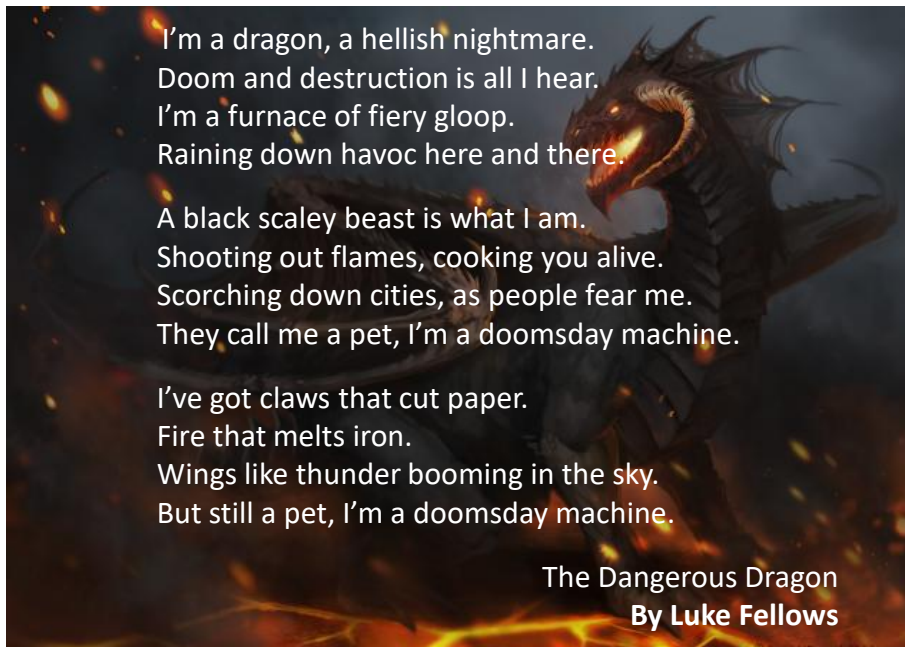

Children's Wellbeing and Schools Act



This week the King signed the Children's Wellbeing and Schools Act. The Act will make important changes focused on keeping children safe, support for families, and ensuring that every child receives a good education. The government is investing £2.4 billion in social care, to improve Family Help Services and make more support available to families experiencing difficulties with mental health.

The government acknowledges the essential role that schools play in safeguarding children, alongside delivering quality education. Emotional wellbeing is also central to this role, nurturing our children in a caring environment, encouraging positive relationships, helping children to understand and manage emotions, and providing early support when worries and challenges arise.

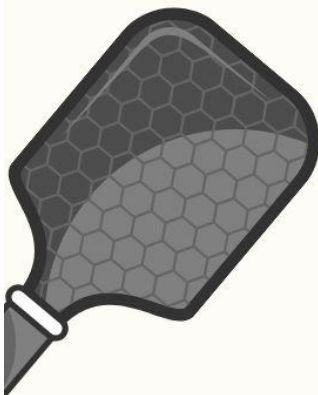

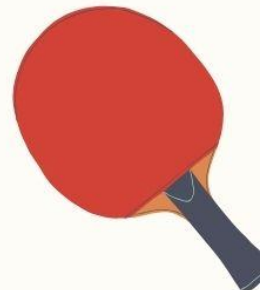
