BRAGGS SCHOOLWEAR

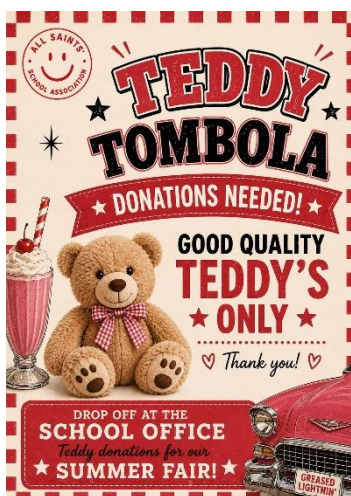

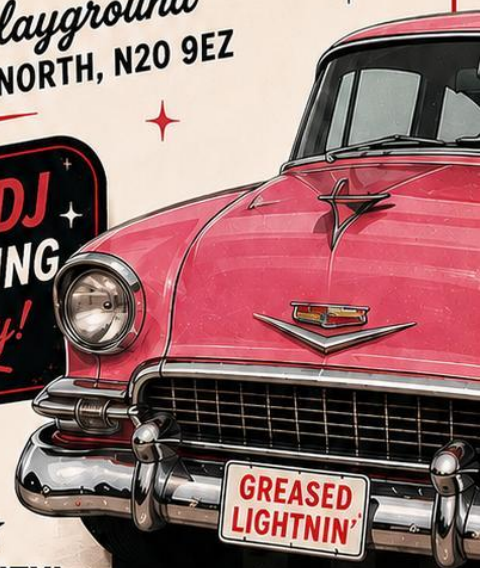
